GLOBAL CALLING CARD USER GUIDE

Calling from within Australia

- 1. Dial 18999 or 1800 551 812 and wait for instructions.
- 2. When requested enter your card number, followed by your PIN, or wait for the operator.
- For Calls within Australia: Enter the area code and telephone number.

For International Calls: Enter 0011, country code, area code and telephone number.

Calling from overseas*

- 1. Dial the Call Home Australia Access Number** for the country you are in.
- 2. When requested enter your card number, followed by your PIN, or wait for the operator.
- 3. **For Calls to Australia:** Enter the area code and telephone number.

For Calls within and between selected countries (Country Connect): Enter 0011, country code, area code and telephone number.

Access to 13, 1300 and mobile numbers

You can access 13, 1300 and mobile numbers (area code not required). Operators cannot connect calls to 13 or 1300 numbers. Some 13 and 1300 numbers are not available when phoning from overseas.

Important: Take care not to reveal your card number and PIN when making calls in public areas. Some hotels may impose surcharges on card calls. Please check with the hotel first.

Assistance: In Australia dial 1300 720 214. From overseas dial the Call Home Australia Access Number for the country you're in and hold for the operator. If you are unable to get through on this number, call +61 2 9342 4511 to report the problem.

Speed dia

When instructed to enter the telephone number, enter your pre-registered speed dial number followed by #, e.g. 1# or 5#

Speed Dial set-up

To set-up your speed dial numbers, please call customer service on 1300 720 214 and have your desired numbers and locations ready.

Follow-on calls

Before your call ends and the person you called hangs up, you can make your next call immediately by pressing ## and following the instructions.

For faster dialling

After dialling 18999 (within Australia), you can enter your card number, PIN, then the area code and telephone number you wish to call (without waiting for the instructions).

Corrections

If you make a mistake when entering numbers, press the * key and re-enter the particular set of numbers you were dialling.

Sending a fax

You can send a fax (using a fax machine) by following the same steps that you use to make a voice call.

Options menu

The Global Calling Card has features that help you keep in touch with friends and family while travelling. To hear the options menu, press the star (*) key when you hear the prompt.

Choices Within Options menu Press 1 to make a call

Press 2 for voicemail: Your family and friends can leave you a voice message by dialling 1300 551 012 when in Australia or +61 2 9776 0403 when overseas. All they need is your mailbox number, which is your 9 digit card number.


To listen to your messages: Press 1 to listen to your messages. After you listen to a message you have the option to; save, delete, replay or forward it.

To set-up your mailbox

Press 2 to record a personal greeting that your friends and family will hear. You have 60 seconds to record.

Languages

Press 3 to change your language. Follow the voice prompts to change to your language of choice. Languages available are: Arabic, Cantonese, English, Indonesian, Japanese, Korean, Mandarin, Thai and Vietnamese.
